FACT SHEET APRIL 2011 DUNCAN SIMONETTE, INC.

I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE – Job Creation

The Department of Development recommends a Downtown Office Incentive of fifty percent (50%) for a period of five (5) years for the purposes of creating 13 new permanent full-time positions and retaining 5 full-time employees with an estimated total payroll of \$565,000.

II. PROJECT HISTORY

Duncan Simonette, Inc. is a law firm that specializes in business, real estate, domestic relations, estate planning, bankruptcy, and additional litigation services. The law firm was created by Brian K. Duncan and David G. Simonette. Legal Services are provided to lenders and borrowers, developers and builders, tenants and landlords.

Duncan Simonette, Inc. is proposing to relocate its corporate headquarters from South High Street to the Downtown Business District by entering into a 7-year lease agreement on a vacant office space consisting of approximately 7,000 square feet located at 155 E. Broad Street Suite 2200. The company will invest approximately \$400,000, which includes leasehold improvements and personal property, create 13 new full-time permanent positions and retain 5 full-time employees.

Duncan Simonette, Inc. is requesting a 50%/5-year Downtown Office Incentive from the City of Columbus to assist in the relocation of its corporate headquarters to the downtown business district.

III. PROJECT INVESTMENT

IV. DECISION & TIMING

The project will begin in May 2011 with a scheduled time of completion for August 2011, contingent upon Columbus City Council approval of the recommended tax incentive.

V. EMPLOYMENT

The project will create 13 new full-time positions with an estimated annual payroll of \$565,000 and retain 5 full-time positions with an annual payroll of approximately \$250,000.

VI. REQUESTED PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

The Department of Development recommends a Downtown Office Incentive equal to fifty percent (50%) of the amount of new employee city income tax withholding for five (5) years.

VII. WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

Employers granted a tax incentive will meet with the Central Ohio Workforce Investment Corporation (COWIC) within 90 days to develop a relationship to assure continuing employment opportunities for Columbus residents who are unemployed or underemployed.
