This memorandum is a recommendation for construction contractor selection and processing the construction legislation for the Morse Road Railroad Bridges Project.

Summarized History: This project is part of the Morse Road Corridor Improvements.

<u>Scope:</u> The project scope includes minor concrete patching and painting two railroad bridges over Morse Road.

Reason for Request: This project is necessary to continue the Morse Road Improvements and fulfills commitments made to the citizens of the Northland area.

<u>Fiscal Impact</u>: The project cost will be paid for with funds from the 2006 Capital Improvement Budget.

<u>Schedule:</u> This project was bid on May 10, 2007. The contract length is 30 days. The Notice to Proceed is expected on or around August 1, 2007.

Construction Cost: The Engineer's Estimate was \$207,022.26.

A bid tabulation was completed for two bidders.

#### Request Detail:

With reference to bids received on May 10, 2007, I wish to make the following recommendation for the subject improvement:

Award be made to the most responsive and responsible bidder, The Righter Company, 2424 Harrison Road, Columbus, Ohio 43204 for their bid of \$337,255.60, which is \$130,233.35 over the Engineer's estimate of \$207,022.26.

The Transportation Division has determined that this bid is acceptable, even though it is \$130,233.35 over the engineer's estimate. The bid was over the engineer's estimate due to an undervalued amount of maintenance of traffic in the consultants estimate. The City could re-bid this project however the results are expected to be the same. The City has identified the funding required for this project.

<u>Emergency Action</u>: Emergency action is necessary in order to meet a scheduled construction start date of August 1, 2007.


