Grantor/Owner, for himself and his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, reserves all existing rights of ingress and egress to and from any residual area (as used herein, the expression "Grantor/Owner" includes the plural, and words in the masculine include the feminine or neuter).

[Surveyor's description of the premises follows]

Situated in the State of Ohio, County of Franklin, City of Columbus located in Quarter Township 2, Township 2, Range 18 (USML), part of Lot 41 of Partition plat of the Scioto Land Company, DB "A" Page 194, destroyed by fire, as demonstrated in SPB 3, Page 136-7. Descriptions of said partition lots are recorded in DB "A" Pages 7 & 14, and being a part of a 9.129 acre tract of land conveyed to FTM Associates L.L.C. by deed of record in I.N. 200402020022728 of the Recorders office, Franklin County, Ohio and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the centerline monument set on Campus View Boulevard at station 59+03.00;

Thence N 86°49'53" W along the centerline of Campus View Boulevard a distance of 149.11 feet to a point, said point being located at station 57+53.89;

Thence N 3°10'07" E a distance of 40.00 feet to an iron pin set in the northerly right-of way line of Campus View Boulevard at the grantor's southwest corner, said iron pin also being the southeast corner of a 7.231 acre tract conveyed to One Crosswoods Associates LLC in IN 200803110036762, said iron pin being 40.00 feet left of station 57+53.89, and being also the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**;

Thence N 03°10'07" E along the grantor's west line and the east line of said One Crosswoods Associates LLC tract a distance of 2.00 feet to a point, said point being 42.00 feet left of station 57+53.89;

Thence crossing said grantor's 9.129 acre tract the next six courses - S 86°49'53" E a distance of 28.84 feet to an iron pin set, said point being 42.00 feet left of station 57+82.74;

Thence N 3°10'07" E a distance of 4.00 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being 46.00 feet left of station 57+82.74;

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Thence S 86°49'53" E a distance of 30.61 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being 46.00 feet left of station 58+13.35;

Thence S 3°10'07" W a distance of 4.00 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being 42.00 feet left of station 58+13.35;

Thence S 86°49'53" E a distance of 36.65 feet to an iron pin set, said iron pin being 42.00 feet left of station 58+50.00;

Thence S 03°10'07" W a distance of 2.00 feet to an iron pin set on the grantor's south line and said northerly right-of way line of Campus View Boulevard, said iron pin being 40.00 feet left of station 58+50.00;

Thence N 86°49'53" W along the grantor's south line and said northerly right-of way line of Campus View Boulevard a distance of 96.11 feet to the **TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING**.

The above described area is contained with the Franklin County Auditor's Parcel Number 610-198388, with a present road of 0.000 acres occupied. Within said boundary is 0.007 acres, more or less.

This description and survey was prepared and reviewed on February 12, 2015, by Joseph S. Bolzenius. All iron pins set are 5/8" rebar (30" long) with a yellow plastic cap stamped "R/W PATRICK INC" and are to be placed at the completion of construction by the City of Columbus Survey Department.

The centerline and stationing described in this document refers to the centerline of construction on file with the City of Columbus plan "Campus View Boulevard Sidewalk Improvements (3114 Dr. E)"

The basis of bearings in this description area based on the State Plane Coordinate System, Ohio South Zone, NAD83 (NSRS 2011), which were determined by GPS observations conducted by the Patrick Engineering survey staff. The Columbus, Mount Vernon and McConnelsville CORS stations were used, which establishes a bearing along the centerline of Campus View Boulevard to be S 86°49'53" E between High Street and Vantage Drive.
