Being a parcel of land lying on the left side of the centerline of right of way of Alum Creek Drive as shown on the centerline plat of FRA-CR122-6.22 as recorded in Plat Book _____, Page ____ of the records of Franklin County and being further described as follows:

Commencing, at a 1 inch iron pipe (found) at the northwesterly corner of dedicated Alum Creek Drive, as shown on Dedication of Alum Creek Drive and Winslow Drive, as recorded in Plat Book 25, Page 114, also being the grantor's northeasterly corner, said corner being on the westerly existing right of way line of Alum Creek Drive, 40.00 feet left of station 226+26.81, and the **Point of Beginning** of the parcel herein described;

Thence, South 37 degrees 00 minutes 56 seconds East, along said existing right of way line and the grantor's easterly property line, a distance of 33.75 feet to a point 40.00 feet left of station 225+92.34;

Thence, South 35 degrees 58 minutes 54 seconds East, continuing along said line, a distance of 280.95 feet to a point 40.00 feet left of station 223+11.39;

Thence, Southwesterly, continuing along said existing right of way line, an arc distance of 30.50 feet, along the arc of a curve deflecting to the right, having a central angle of 87 degrees 22 minutes 58 seconds, a radius of 20.00 feet, and a chord that bears South 07 degrees 42 minutes 35 seconds West, a

distance of 27.63 feet, to a point on the northerly existing right of way line of Winslow Drive and the grantor's southerly property line, 59.09 feet left of station 222+91.41;
