Attached please find a request to sell portions of Morris and Alton Avenues from the first alley south of 5th Avenue to 4th Avenue and a portion of 4th Avenue between Morris Avenue and Alton Avenue. Sale of these rights-of-way to Ralston Industries will increase storage facilities and provide additional security to their adjacent properties. The Real Estate Division has established a value of \$14,957.50 for these rights-of-way as indicated on the attached form. The City notified Ralston Industries of this value and Ralston Industries returned a signed letter authorizing the City to proceed with those steps necessary to transfer this excess right-of-way.

It is now necessary for the Department of Development to review the attached information and identify any possible mitigation. When your review is complete and any outstanding issues have been resolved, please complete the final portion of the attached form and place this item on the Land Review Commission agenda for their consideration.

Dear Mr. Solomon:

The City of Columbus, Transportation Division, has reviewed the request you submitted on behalf of Ralston Industries, Inc., regarding their proposed acquisition of those rights-of-way identified as portions of Morris and Alton Avenues from the first alley south of 5th Avenue to 4th Avenue and that portion of 4th Avenue between Morris and Alton Avenues. It is the City's understanding acquisition of these rights-of-way will allow Ralston Industries, Inc., to provide additional storage and increased security at this facility. Columbus City Council Resolution Number 113X-86 provides for the sale of excess City owned property. After investigation, it was determined the City has no objections to the sale of these rights-of-way subject to the retention of a general utility easement for those utilities currently located therein. Based upon information provided by the Franklin County Auditor the City has estimated a value of \$14,957.50 for these rights-of-way.

If Ralston Industries, Inc., desires to proceed with the acquisition of the above referenced rights-of-way please have this "Authorization to Proceed to Land Review Commission" letter signed and dated in the space provided below then returned, within thirty days, to Ms. Patricia A. Austin, P.E., Administrator, Transportation Division, Public Service Department, 109 North Front Street, 3rd Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, Attention: Mary Lu English.

If Ralston Industries, Inc. objects to the estimated value of \$14,957.50 you will need to contact Ms. Donna Hunter, Administrator of the Land Management Office, to discuss a possible reduction of this amount. For your convenience I have attached a list of valid mitigating circumstances that the City will consider when reducing right-of-way transfer prices. Please include a copy of any correspondence you send to Ms. Hunter when you return this "authorization to proceed" letter. Unless mitigating circumstances that directly benefit the Transportation Division can be identified, our Division policy requires that a recommendation to transfer at full price be forwarded from this Division to the Development Department.

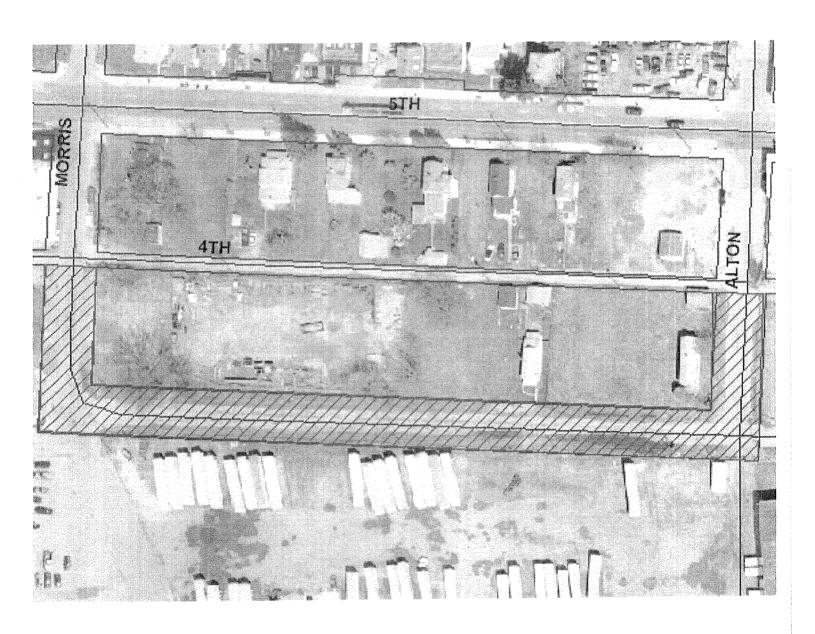
