The Franklin County Engineer's Office has received and reviewed the pavement cores taken on Chippewa Street on 6/30/04. This letter serves as a supplement to my previous letter dated May 12, 2004 (attached). The following are requests based upon the review of the pavement core samples.

- 3-inch overlay on Chippewa Street.
- Remove and replace the existing asphalt from the bridge.
 - After removal of the asphalt, Franklin County Engineer crews will waterproof the deck prior to the developer's crews replacing the asphalt (3-inch depth).
- Full-depth reconstruction of 50-feet on each side of the bridge.
- 2-foot aggregate berms (chip/seal) along Chippewa Street.
- 3-foot feathers into all driveways, including gravel drives.

Please provide our office with a written commitment to the items listed above and within the May 12, 2004 attached letter from our office prior to this case being heard by Columbus City Council. Commitment to all the improvements will need to be referenced within the limitation text for the rezoning. Please submit a revised copy of the text to our office for review.
