The proposed contract with Adrian L. Wallick Company, is for Contract S78, Multiple Hearth Incinerator Rehabilitation at the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant (SWWTP).

The major work for this project consists of refractory work for hearth and wall repair of Multiple Hearth Incinerators No. 3 and 4 and associated replacement of the following: Venturi ductwork, circular by-pass stack, two expansion joints in exhaust ductwork, incinerator roof plate, hearth repair and associated and/or damaged refractory.

An Alternate Bid Item 1 is also proposed which consists of removing the two existing fume incinerators and its associated equipment and patching and repairing the existing structures where the removal took place.

An Alternate Bid Item 2 is also proposed which consists of removal of three existing burners in Hearth No.4 and replacing them with three new burners. This will include new burner boxes.

Both Alternate Bid Items were accepted by the City.
