The purpose of this project is to construct necessary improvements to the water distribution system in the Dundee Avenue Area. The improvements identified in the scope of work will replace or rehabilitate water lines that have high break histories and require frequent maintenance. This project includes replacing or rehabilitating approximately 12,825 linear feet of 6-inch and 8-inch and water lines within the project area.

This project is located within the “Eastmoor/Walnut Ridge” and “Eastland/Brice” community planning areas, with the majority of the project in the Eastmoor/Walnut Ridge planning area. The streets include Dundee Ave., Wilton Dr., Wilton Pl., Dundee Pl., Clyde Pl., E. Livingston Ave. South Service Road, E. Livingston Ave. North Service Road, E. Livingston Ave., Arkwood Court, Dort Pl., Walkath Dr., Geomar Dr., Chrisview Dr., Striebel Dr., Striebel Road, Dehner Dr., Cardston Ct., Seaforth Pl., North Rotunda Ct., and Easthaven Court South.

6. **A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**

The duration of the design phase for this project is 13 months. Part of the Consultant’s scope of work is to provide record drawings after the construction of this project is completed. Therefore, it is estimated that the end of this agreement will occur in late 2018.

7. **A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

The goal of this project is to replace or rehabilitate the existing 2-inch, 6-inch and 8-inch water lines that have a high break frequency. Replacement of these water lines will improve water service, decrease burden on water maintenance operations, and reduce water loss. The Neighborhood Liaison(s) will be contacted and informed of this project during the design phase. Further community outreach may result through the Neighborhood Liaison Program.

8. **An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.**

The proposed agreement amount is \$188,299.31, including a 15% contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work. No contract modifications are anticipated at this time; however, an engineering exigency might later compel modification of this contract, if unforeseen difficulties are encountered.
