The original contract for an operational review and strategic plan was bid for one (1) year from the date of execution, with the option to renew for an additional two (2) years on a year-to-year basis, or a portion thereof, based upon mutual agreement of the parties, availability of funding, and approval by Columbus City Council. The original authorizing ordinance was ordinance 3470-2022. It did not automatically renew and future contract modifications were anticipated. A second ordinance, 1479-2023, authorized funding for the second renewal option to cover phases 4-6. That ordinance, in error, did not extend the time period of the contract so it expired. A third ordinance, 0136-2024, waived the provisions of competitive bidding to provide funding for the final phase and tasks 7-8 of the overall project. The Department has a desire to continue the study for an additional, unplanned phase. The continuity from earlier phases means it is again in the best interest of the City to waive competitive bidding.
