In the mid 1990s, she provided oversight for public art efforts including a three-year, eight-county Save Outdoor Sculpture! Program that resulted in an inventory and initial condition assessment of outdoor public art.

For Otterbein College where she is adjunct instructor in the Department of Art, Nance developed the introductory curriculum for the arts administration minor.
