This project consists of the replacement of approximately 305 LF of 12-inch diameter, 1,009 LF of 15-inch diameter and 338 of 18-inch diameter sanitary sewer pipe; the reinstatement of approximately 26 service connections; the removal and replacement of 7 sanitary sewer manholes; the relocation of approximately 200 LF of 6-inch diameter ductile iron water pipe; the by-pass pumping, maintaining traffic and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract in accordance with the plans and specifications.

A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.

The Notice to Proceed will be issued to the contractor in late February or early March, 2006. All work is to be completed within 180 days. There is no further work anticipated for this project.

An estimate of the full estimated cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.

The Division does not anticipate any future work under this contract. The contract amount as shown on the lowest, best, responsive and responsible bid submitted by the Underground Utilities, Inc. is \$738,778.80.
