

Non-Traditional Educational Learning Center (NELC)

Establish a program that provides an alternative for West High School students facing suspension or are at risk of falling behind in school, for the 2025 – 2026 school year.

- + Students are referred to the program for 3 5 days
- + Students who attend this program will not be counted as absent.
- + Maximum of 15 students in the NELC at a time.
- + May also accommodate students who are experiencing grief, bullying, or are exhibiting poor attendance.
- + Runs the same time as a regular school day.
- + Includes social-emotional supports from licensed counselors.
- + Includes a summer program that will support a select number of NELC students, preventing learning loss providing structure across the summer months.

Request: \$172,238

- + Case Manager, Teacher, Program Supervisor 2.4 FTE + Benefits
- + Supplies, Materials, Training
- + 10% de minimis

YMCA

- Administer and oversee the program
- + Provide licensed counselor
- Facilitate intake and outtake process in with West HS

Hilltop Library

+ Host the program for 2025 – 2026 school year

West HS

- Identify students that attend program
- Transportation to and from West HS
- + Provide safety/security supports
- + Provide licensed counselor
- Facilitate intake and outtake process with YMCA

Target Outcomes

- + Increased graduation rates and percentage of on-track students.
- + Decreased dropout rate and chronically absent students.
- Decreased number of students with repeat disciplinary actions.
