Greg Davies is the Chief of Staff for City of Columbus Mayor Andrew J. Ginther. In his current capacity, Davies is responsible for managing Mayor Ginther's office, as well as managing Mayor Ginther's cabinet, comprised of thirteen directors.

Prior to serving as Chief of Staff, Davies was the Public Utilities Director for Columbus Mayor Michael B. Coleman for four years. The Department is comprised of three divisions—Water, Sewers and Drains, and Power—and has 1,250 employees and an annual budget of roughly \$600 million. He has also served as Deputy Chief of Staff for Mayor Coleman and as Deputy Director of the City's Development Department, where he implemented the Mayor's regional growth program and managed Home Again, a \$25 million vacant and abandoned property program created by Mayor Coleman. Davies began his career at the City in 1999 as the Public Information Officer for the Columbus Department of Public Utilities.

Davies graduated from The Ohio State University with a degree in English.
