CIP # 670853-100000 This project will provide construction administration and construction inspection services for the Jasonway and Knightsbridge Street Lighting Improvement Project. The Street Lighting Improvements for Jasonway and Knightsbridge consists of the installation of street lighting on Knightsbridge Blvd from Henderson Rd to Olentangy River Rd and on Jasonway from Bethel Rd to Olentangy River Rd. This is a 3-wire underground lighting system with 45 poles and LED luminaires to be installed. Project is in the northwest community planning area.

6. **A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**

All work shall be substantially complete within 270 calendar days of the Notice to Proceed, with final completion to occur 365 calendar days. The City anticipates issuing a Notice to proceed on or about 02/01/2023.

7. **A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

The installation and conversion to LED lighting within the project area would provide both an additional sense of safety and security to the residents. This may also deter criminal activity, which would lessen the financial impact on city resources such as the Police and Fire departments.

8. **An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.**

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$133,788.46, including a 15% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work. No contract modifications are anticipated at this time; however, construction exigency might later compel modification of this contract, if unforeseen difficulties are encountered.
