TO ACCOMPANY LEGISLATION WHICH WAIVES ANY PROVISIONS OF COLUMBUS CITY CODES CHAPTER 329

1. In accordance with section 329.27 of the Columbus City Code, City Council may determine that the City's best interest is served by waiving the City Code Formal Bid procedures for the following reason(s): (Note that these reasons are all based on time. Currently, formal bid average completion time is 189 calendar days.)

- An unanticipated breakdown created an unplanned, emergency need.
- The item to be purchased is of a perishable nature, the price or availability will perish before the formal bid process can be completed.
- Need to extend an existing contract for one year or more where no provision for extension was included in the original bid/contract.
- Need to increase a contract for additional supplies/services, although the original contract obligations have been fulfilled.
- A new law or regulation requires immediate compliance; there is insufficient time to accomplish formal competitive bidding and satisfy the needs in order to comply.
- Other: Two of the bids received had warranty terms and conditions that deemed their bids non-responsive. Award is only being made to those two vendors for items that no responsive bid was received.

2. Informal bid procedure used: Yes No **Explain:**

Formal bid process was used – SA005377 opened May 15, 2014. Four bids were received and of those two were responsive and two non-responsive.

3. Informal bids received and prices for each:

Formal bid process was used, there were 776 line items contained in the bid.

4. If lowest bid was not accepted, Explain:

Low responsive bid was accepted; for items that no responsive bid was received then the lowest non-responsive bid was accepted.
