AMENDMENT TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE HOUSING OF PRISONERS Between THE FRANKLIN COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS AND CITY OF COLUMBUS

This Amendment is entered into on this _____ day of _____, 2023 by and between the City of Columbus("Municipality") and the Franklin County Board of Commissioners ("County"). This is an amendment to the contract that was originally approved pursuant to Resolution No. 0718-94 on July 19, 1994 and authorized by Ordinance No. 1295-94 on June 21, 1994. (the "Original Contract").

I Transporting Prisoners

Section 6 of the Original Contract is hereby deleted and replaced by the following:

6. All expenses of transporting prisoners, except prisoner convey between the Correction Centers and Municipal Court as specified in paragraph 5, including their return to the place from which they were sentenced and including the expense of retaking prisoners who may violate any probation when such probation is granted with the consent of the sentencing tribunal, shall be paid in all cases by the Municipality in the following manner:

The allocated share of the expenses of transporting prisoners, net of any reimbursement from the Franklin County Municipal Court, shall be apportioned on the same basis made applicable to all municipalities and unincorporated areas of Franklin County, which shall be fifty per cent (50%) on the basis of population and fifty per cent (50%) on the basis of the real property, tangible personal property, and public utility tax duplicate of each political subdivision in the County.

The charges shall be in arrears so that payment reflects the prior year costs. Following the initial payment, a reconciliation shall be made each year and adjustments between actual and charged expenses. Notice of the amount shall be provided to each political subdivision by November 1 of each year.

II Administrative and Specifications Requirements

That all other terms and conditions of the Original Contract and all extensions and modifications thereto not expressly modified herein shall remain in full force and effect and remain legally binding upon the parties.
