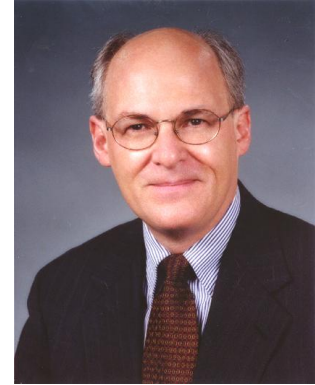


RICHARD P. FAHEY

Mr. Fahey is a partner in the Columbus office practicing in the environmental group. Prior to joining Vorys, he was a partner at Arter & Hadden LLP and chair of the environmental law practice group. His environmental practice includes counseling clients on compliance issues, including state and federal regulations relating to hazardous and solid waste; underground storage tanks; groundwater management and water rights; Superfund; and property redevelopment. Mr. Fahey has developed and implemented environmental audits and compliance programs on behalf of industries, with an emphasis on corporate officer liability issues.

Mr. Fahey served as the Chief of the Natural Resources Law Section of the Ohio Attorney General's Office (1975-76) and as the Assistant Ohio Attorney General, Environmental Section (1973-75).

Mr. Fahey authored numerous environmental articles and books including "Underground Storage Tanks: A Primer on the New Federal Regulatory System," Monograph No. 11, American Bar Association Natural Resources, Energy, and Environmental Law Monograph Series, 1989, and "Underground Storage Tanks" (Second Edition), American Bar Association SONREEL, 1995.

Mr. Fahey is admitted to practice in Ohio and New Mexico, before the United States District Court for the Southern and Northern Districts of Ohio and the United States Tenth District Court of Appeals. He is a member of the American (Natural Resources and Environmental Law), New Mexico, Ohio State (Environmental Law Committee) and Columbus (Environmental Law Committee) Bar Associations. He was a mayoral appointee for the City of Columbus Charter Review Commission and serves on the Board of Directors of the National Audubon Society-Ohio (1999-2003), the Board of Directors of Pilot Dogs, Inc. (1993-present) and Communities in Schools, Inc. (2000-present).

Mr. Fahey was elected to the Columbus Public Schools Board of Education (1986-1993). During that time, he served as President (1989), Vice President (1988), and Chairman of the Legal, Legislative and Policy Committee. Mr. Fahey formerly was an Adjunct Professor at Capital University Law School and The Ohio State University College of Law where he taught

environmental and natural resources law. He was an instructor on Civil Procedure in the Capital University Law School Paralegal Training Program. Mr. Fahey is listed in the 1997-2003 editions of *The Best Lawyers in America* and *Who's Who in American Law*, 1984-2003.
