

**PETITION FOR CREATION
OF THE
REAUTHORIZED CAPITAL CROSSROADS SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF
COLUMBUS**

The undersigned do hereby respectfully petition to create the Reauthorized Capital Crossroads Special Improvement District of Columbus (the "Reauthorized District") and to approve a levy and Plan for Services (the "Plan") pursuant to Chapter 1710 of the Ohio Revised Code. The boundaries of the Reauthorized District, services under the Plan, and area within which the Plan will be executed are described and shown in the attached Exhibit. Each of the undersigned is the owner, or the authorized signatory of the owner, of the property or properties set forth below, which comprise 60% or more of the front footage of property abutting upon the streets, alleys, public roads, places, boulevards, parkways, park entrances, easements and other public improvements situated in the District.

The undersigned acknowledge that the Reauthorized District shall be managed and administered by Reauthorized Capital Crossroads Special Improvement District of Columbus, Inc., an Ohio non-profit corporation to be formed for such purpose. The undersigned further acknowledge that the approval of this petition will permit:

- (1) the undersigned to incorporate the Reauthorized District;
- (2) the property owners in the Reauthorized District to elect a Board of Trustees;
- (3) the levy of an annual assessment of \$1,580,000 on properties within the Reauthorized District;
- (4) the exercise of discretion by trustees of the Reauthorized District on how to allocate funds among the services set forth in the Plan;
- (5) the cost of the Plan to be \$1,980,000 per year, including contributions of \$200,000 each from the City of Columbus and Central Ohio Transit Authority, and that these contributions by the City of Columbus and Central Ohio Transit Authority are necessary to deliver an adequate level of services on High Street;
- (6) the board of trustees for the Reauthorized District to have the option of terminating the SID Plan if COTA or the City of Columbus do not make an annual \$200,000 contribution.
