IN22- Reallocation Process Budget Revision Needed

The IN22 grant year will be extended to end on 9/29/2021. An additional \$5,500 will be allocated to every subrecipient's Deliverable 7A (Strategy 1). The ODH Grant Consultants have already prepared Budget Justifications/Narratives for your convenience. You will receive a separate email from them with additional guidance. Additionally, you must complete your budget revision electronically in GMIS by **8/24/2021**. Failure to upload a signed copy of the updated Budget Justification and complete the Budget Revision in GMIS will result in the loss of additional funds.

Additionally:

- The Quarterly Grant call scheduled for August 17th is cancelled. Instead, the final call for this grant year will be held during the September 8th Project DAWN call.
- Outstanding deliverables are now due on September 29th.
- The Quarterly Progress Report (QPR) has been updated to allow reporting for the month of September.
- Funds for additional naloxone during the extra month will be available. Please contact your
