Dear Tracie:

As you know, the EcoSmart Choice program was instituted with approval of the AMP Board of Trustees and includes a mechanism to return unused program funds to participating members through sustainability grants. Sustainability grants are intended to reward EcoSmart Choice participating communities who demonstrate their commitment to sustainability through local projects focused on environmental, economic, and community benefits. The sustainability grants program ensures that the participating local community receives the full benefit of their investment in green energy and sustainability if market REC prices are lower than anticipated.

Columbus is eligible for grant disbursement of up to \$50,366 which represents the proportional share of remaining program funds available from the 2018 EcoSmart Choice program year. At this time, we are requesting applications for local sustainability projects that can be partially or fully funded through this sustainability grant. Please complete the attached application by April 1, 2019. We anticipate all funds to be disbursed by May 1, 2019.

## **EcoSmart Choice Sustainability Grant Proposal 2019**

As a part of the Bloomberg American Cities Climate Challenge (ACCC) grant, Columbus has a goal of conducting 30,000 audits by 2020 within the Columbus region. This goal involves a partnership between AEP, Columbia Gas, City of Columbus, and the Division of Power. The goal will help Columbus residents increase their home energy efficiency and save move on their utility bills. DOP proposes to utilize the \$50,366 grant funds to 1) establish an online home energy assessment platform that will allow our customers to answer questions and get educated about their home energy usage, and 2) provide energy efficiency kits to each of our customers who completes the assessment. The kits will be similar to AEP's kit which include LED bulbs, LED nightlights, a smart power strip and a low-flow showerhead. We will need to contract with a third party to purchase kit materials and to provide fulfilment/mailing of the kits. This program will serve any DOP residential customer including both single family and multi-unit dwelling, and will be specifically marketed to those who live in the ACCC target areas. Energy efficiency kits will be offered on a first come, first served basis until funding has been exhausted.
