KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that The American Chemical Society, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the United States of America, hereinafter called the "Grantor", in consideration of One Dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations to it paid by the City of Columbus, Ohio, hereinafter called the "Grantee", the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey to said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, a permanent easement and right of way over and through the following described real estate in the City of Columbus, Chio, and described as follows:

> Being a Ten (10) foot strip of land through the premises of the Grantor, as the same is shown on the drawing attached hereto and incorporated herein.

for the purpose of constructing, using and maintaining a storm sewer, tributary connections and appurtenant works in any part of said strip, including the right to clean, repair and care for said sewer, together with the right of access to said strip for said purpose.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the same to said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, for the uses and purposes hereinbefore mentioned.


