Work to be performed in this series of contracts is to provide cost effective Construction Management; Field Representation; Inspection Testing; Instrumentation/Control Design, Integration and Support Services; and services for maintenance of operations during construction for various capital improvements projects for the Water Supply/Technical Support group that begin construction in the years 2011-2015.
6. **A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**
Professional Construction Management services will be provided under several contracts between the City and the URS team. The first contract will be executed as soon as possible to allow the Professional Construction Management Team to perform a constructability review of the Upground Reservoir Project prior to advertisement for bid which is slated for December 2010. Additional contracts for Professional Construction Management will be executed for projects included in the Division of Power & Water (Water) CIP for 2011 – 2015.
7. **An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.**

\$50,000,000.00

The intent is to establish a multi-year contract with fixed direct labor, overhead, and fixed fee rates. Appropriations for individual projects will be through planned contract modifications

duly authorized by City Council. The first contract will be in the amount of \$200,000.00 to perform a constructability review for the Upground Reservoir project prior to advertising for construction in December 2010.

The subconsultant team member firms identified for this phase of the work, Constructability Review of the Upground Reservoir Project, is a limited number of the total project team firms which will participate in future phases of the work. This phase of work includes three subconsultant firms; future phases of the work will include 12 subconsultant firms.

The next contract is anticipated to be legislated in the first half of 2011.
