**This project consists of furnishing of all materials; equipment and labor necessary to renovate the 80 year old outlet works structures at O'Shaughnessy Dam. Specific Items include: replacement of sluice gates and motor operators, replacement of bar screens, installing trash booms, replacing various architectural features and replacing and or upgrading instrumentation. A portion of this work is in direct response to requirements of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission who has regulatory jurisdiction over this dam.**
