There is an immediate need for the Division of Fire to purchase a heavy rescue vehicle; funds have been approved for transfer from the Special Income Tax Fund for this purchase, as there are insufficient funds within the Safety Voted Bond Fund for this purchase. Several manufacturers were surveyed to find a vehicle in production that would be available within a short period of time. Emergency One, Inc. has a vehicle in production that would meet the Division of Fire's needs; it will be available in October, at least twelve (12) months earlier than if bids were solicited via formal bid process.
