1. Reasons for waiving City Code bid procedure:

2. Detailed explanation of reason (must be completed by division):

New CJIS requirements were implemented on September 30, 2013 which require 2-factor authentication in mobile police units for approved access to the LEADS systems. To meet this new requirement the Division began evaluating and testing new technology in June 2013. During the testing and evaluation phase the division became aware that new software and hardware would be necessary to support 2 factor authentication technology. In June 2013 the division began a large-scale purchase of new in-cruiser laptop equipment to support new software. The testing process was completed in early November and a 2 factor solution was selected. Because compliance is critical to police operations, the Division must move to purchase and implement the solution immediately. A bid waiver is immediately requested for the purchase of 2-Factor Authentication One licenses, maintenance, and software, which is manufactured by NetMotion and resold by Upstate Wholesale Supply dba BRITE Computers.

3. Informal procedure used:

- telephone quotations
- written quotations
- negotiations

4. Informal bids received and prices for each:

- 1. Brite - \$67,554.84
- 2. Feeny Wireless - \$73,686.60
- 3. NetMotion Wireless -\$80,574.00

Sgt. Lisath contacted authorized re-sellers of the 2 Factor Authentication (2FA) to obtain the informal bids. He received this information from the manufacturer of 2FA.
