Attached please find a request to sell the alley south of Greenlawn Avenue between Front Street and the alley east thereof to facilitate future development of the adjacent properties. A total value of \$4,851.00 has been determined for this excess right of way as indicated on the attached form. The abutting property owners, Borchers Carpet Cleaning and Greenlawn/Front Ltd., have been contacted. Borchers Carpet Cleaning originally provided a letter stating their intention to purchase the south half of this alley, then submitted a letter withdrawing their request to purchase. Greenlawn/Front Ltd. has notified this office they will purchase the entire alley and has returned a signed letter authorizing the City to proceed with those steps necessary to transfer this excess right-of-way.
