Installation of approximately 1,100 linear feet of 8" water line and appurtenances along Ohio Avenue, and other such work as may be necessary to complete the contract, in accordance with the plans and specifications set forth in this Invitation For Bid (IFB).

The planning area for this project is "Near East" and includes North Ohio Avenue north of E. Long Street and south of Mt. Vernon Avenue.

- 6. A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.**

Contract work is required to be completed in a manner acceptable to the City within 75 days from the date that a Notice To Proceed (NTP) is given by the City.

- 7. A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

The goal of this project is to replace the existing 6-inch water line with an 8-inch water line. This replacement is needed to improve water flow in the area including improving water service to the new Columbus Metropolitan Housing Authority project. The Neighborhood Liaison(s) will be contacted and informed of this project. Further community outreach may result through the Neighborhood Liaison Program.

8. An estimate of the full cost of the Contract including a separate estimate of any and all phases or proposed future contract modifications.

The bid amount and proposed award amount is \$335,006.10, including a 10% construction contingency amount that will be utilized to fund needed and approved changes in the work. No contract modifications are anticipated at this time; however, construction exigency might later compel modification of this contract, if unforeseen difficulties are encountered.
