Due to the unique matters above, the anticipated cost being less than \$38,045.50, and in consideration of Greenwood 360's having a project lead available who is certified in fraud examination, efforts to bid or solicit an alternate item were not considered necessary.

3. Describe efforts to determine/verify that the company is the sole source:

The Department of Finance and Management collaborated with the Department of Development to assess potential offerors and solutions. No other organizations were identified with the same data access and personnel certified in fraud examination.

4. Indicate how the price or fee structure was determined:

The orginal contract was a fixed blended hourly rate of \$150 per hour times an estimated maximum of 325 hours rounded up to the nearest \$1,000 dollars. The contract extension will utilize the remaning funds from the original contract - \$38,045.50.
