2. Detailed explanation of reason (must be completed by division):

The Department utilized a formal competitive process to advertise and bid this job pursuant to Columbus City Code 329.09. Capital City Electric's total bid price was \$582,598.67, which is \$101,247.73 less than the next lowest bidder.

However, upon review of the bid, on one item, a lump sum was used by Capital City Electric rather than a unit price as requested. If the unit price was applied, the total bid for item 5: Removal and Installation of Emergency Lighting Ballast (Complete) would be over \$207,000 for 25 fixtures, indicating an obvious error had been made by Capital City Electric.

Capital City Electric has clarified its bid that a lump sum was mistakenly provided for that item, and has clarified how the lump sum it provided translates to the unit price. This clarification does not change the total bid amount and Capital City Electric is still the lowest bid.

In order to allow DPU to award to the lowest bidder, notwithstanding the obvious error, waiver is requested. The City Attorney's office was consulted on this matter and supports this request.
