Greg Davies is the Deputy Chief of Staff for City of Columbus Mayor Michael B. Coleman. Davies is responsible for the management and tracking of the Mayor's priority projects, particularly focused on issues related to development, utilities and technology. He also manages the City's Environmental Steward, Homeless Director and helps direct the Mayor's Policy Office. Prior to becoming Deputy Chief of Staff, Davies served as Deputy Director of the Development Department, as well as Assistant Director for Neighborhood and Community Services. In that capacity, Davies was responsible for creating and directing Mayor Michael B. Coleman's Home Again initiative, a \$25 million program designed to mitigate vacant and abandoned properties. He also served as Deputy Director for Regional Growth and spent six years in the City of Columbus Department of Public Utilities. Davies was a print journalist for five years before joining the City of Columbus and received a Bachelor of Arts degree in English from The Ohio State University.
