# FACT SHEET MATIC INSURANCE SERVICES INC. MARCH 2018

## I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE – JOB CREATION

The Department of Development recommends a Downtown Office Incentive of fifty percent (50%) for a period of up to four (4) consecutive years in consideration of a total investment of approximately \$400,000 and the creation of fifty (50) new full-time permanent positions.

# II. PROJECT HISTORY

Matic Insurance Services Inc. was founded in 2014 in California as a technology company integrating into the insurance industry. They developed an application that is used to help borrowers obtain homeowners insurance during the mortgage loan process. In 2016, Matic Insurance Services Inc. selected Columbus, Ohio for their agent call center to assist customers directed to them by lenders in selecting the most appropriate insurance carrier and policy. Matic Insurance Services Inc. has recently landed several large integration partnerships which require an expansion of their insurance agent services as well as their legal team and administrative staff. This expansion could take place in their California or Columbus offices. Matic would like to expand in Columbus to take advantage of relationships with the insurance carriers headquartered in Columbus.

Matic Insurance Services Inc. is considering leasing 12,000 square feet of office space at 2 Miranova Place, Suite 400, Columbus, Ohio 43215 ("Project Site") to expand their client services office and add a new legal department and administrative services. The project involves a total investment of approximately \$400,000 related to leasehold improvements and the acquisition of furniture, fixtures, and information technology equipment. Matic Insurance Services Inc. will retain ten (10) full-time employees with an annual payroll of approximately \$645,000 and create fifty (50) new full-time permanent positions with an estimated annual payroll of approximately \$3,317,000.

Matic Insurance Services Inc. is requesting a Downtown Office Incentive of fifty percent (50%) for a period of up to four (4) consecutive years to assist in the expansion of their client services operations and creation of legal and administrative support operations.

#### IV. DECISION & TIMING

The real property improvements and hiring are expected to begin April 2018 with a scheduled time of completion in November 2019, contingent upon Columbus City Council approval of the recommended incentive.

## V. EMPLOYMENT

The project will create 50 new full-time permanent office positions with an estimated annual payroll of approximately \$3,317,000 and retain 10 full-time jobs with an annual payroll of \$645,000.
