Due to the secure nature of the work, this contract was bid using a two phase secure bidding process. In the first phase the City advertised for contractors to submit Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) for this contract. The SOQ's were evaluated and two bidders, SimplexGrinnell L.P. and G4S Technology LLC, were short-listed as qualified to perform the work based on the SOQ's submitted. As part of the second phase, both short-listed contractors were sent the Invitation for Bids. Two (2) sealed proposals for this contract, one from SimplexGrinnell L.P. and one from G4S Technology LLC, were received and publicly opened on January 16, 2013.
