Ordinance No. 0318-2011 approved legislation for an ODNR surety bond of \$530,000 for the construction of Upground Reservoir - Part I (CIP 690370-100000 – Part I, Contract 1032 – Part I, Upground Reservoir - Site No. 2). That bond was placed in the State of Ohio's State Treasury Asset Reserve of Ohio (Star Ohio) Program and covers the period between initiation of construction through ODNR's construction inspection approval at the end of construction.

This legislation will request \$500,000 for additional surety bond funds required by ODNR. This bond will be deposited into the same State of Ohio's State Treasury Asset Reserve of Ohio (Star Ohio) Program as the first bond and will cover the period between ODNR's construction inspection approval and ODNR's final acceptance after filling of the reservoir. This legislative request was planned and accounted for in Ordinance No. 0318-2011.
