This is a division wide contract to provide Specialized Machining and Fabrication Services on an annual basis for the two wastewater treatment facilities within the City. Currently, the Division of Sewerage and Drainage requires these services for the Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant and the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant. Typical work consists in general of specialized machining and fabrication services for the Jackson Pike and Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plants.

4. A narrative timeline for the contract including a beginning date, beginning and ending dates for known phases of the contract and a projected ending date.

This Contract shall remain in force for a period one year with the option to renew each year for an additional two years upon mutual agreement between the parties and approval by the Columbus City Council. Funding of this contract will be on an incremental basis, unless terminated by the City, as described in the Special Provisions of the Contract Documents. The City shall have the option to renew the Contract for an additional three years upon mutual agreement between the parties and approval by the Columbus City Council. This contract was entered into on April 8, 2008. This modification is for an additional year through April 8, 2011.

This is the first proposed modification.

This is an annual service contract and as such the work will be the same or similar for each fiscal year. Therefore, these, once again, includes Specialized Machining and Fabrication for the Jackson Pike and Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plants.
