## Good morning!

The Fire Prevention Bureau (FPB) has finalized an award recommendation on RFQ011862 / Smoke & CO Detectors and Educational Materials. All vendors bid the specified product, with the exception of Line #70.

On Line #70, FPB reviewed the low bid submitted by Sky Resources (\$21,500) for an alternate product ("Universal" / #MC304S/#MC304SB), and found that it does not meet the bid specifications as it is for a "combo unit" unit that combines *both* an ionization and photo electric sensor into one unit. Bid specs. were for an individual alarm unit with an ionization sensor since there are different areas within a home where an ionization vs. a photo electric sensor should be utilized (i.e.: some sensor types should *not* be used outside a bathroom or kitchen.) The next low bid was submitted by Asset Lighting (\$22,440.00) & was also for an alternate product ("First Alert"/#SA350B) which *does meet the bid specifications*.
