RE: Recent Organizational Changes Within GFT

Ms. Kohlberg or To Whom it May Concern,

An affiliate of GFT Infrastructure, Inc. (formerly known as Gannett Fleming, Inc.) has completed a merger with an affiliate of TranSystems Corporation of Ohio ("TranSystems"), effective August 5, 2024 (the "Transaction"). As a result of the Transaction, TranSystems became a subsidiary within the GFT Infrastructure, Inc. organization. Since the closing of the Transaction, the overall organization has rebranded as GFT, and GFT has been working to consolidate operations, systems and people. Effective July 5, 2025, employees of TranSystems have been transferred and are now employed by GFT Infrastructure, Inc. GFT Infrastructure, Inc. will be the organization's main operating entity and, while TranSystems will continue to exist as a subsidiary for a period following this corporate consolidation, its operations will wind down as contracts are assigned. Please accept this letter as GFT's formal request to assign any existing and active TranSystems contracts to GFT Infrastructure, Inc.
