- 2. Scope of Work to be performed: This is a contract for the removal and disposal of six existing oil-bath type air filtration units located in existing Aeration Control Buildings A & B at the Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant. Six new heavy-duty, automated, renewable-media air filter units will be installed in the existing buildings. This work also includes the installation and commissioning of local control panels for the equipment.
- 3. Schedule to contract completion; "phasing": The contract documents do not include any language on contract duration or completion time. It is anticipated by the specifier that this work can be completed in 120 days. This contract is therefore estimated to continue through July, 2006, if begun in March, 2006 as expected.
- 4. Estimated Costs over the full contract period: The initial cost of the project will be \$209,400.00. There are no contract modifications contemplated at this time.
