## Explanation of Legislation

**OBJECTIVE:** The purpose of this legislation is to authorize the Purchasing Administrator to participate in contracts for the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for contracts selected to be established under Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (Am. Sub. H.B. No. 100).

**NEED:** Any city agency who has a need for items from contracts that the Purchasing Administrator selects as a contract for which the City of Columbus would benefit may process legislation to purchase from the contract.

**BACKGROUND:** Effective March 6, 1986, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act provided the opportunity for Ohio's political subdivisions to buy goods and services from the State of Ohio purchasing contracts. The contracts that are available shall first be selected and authorized for use by different city agencies by the Purchasing Administrator and administered thereafter by the Division of Purchasing.

**FUNDING:** There is no charge by the State of Ohio to use the cooperative purchasing contracts. The only expense will be for the reproduction of contracts selected for use. A charge of ten cents per page will be assessed and will be absorbed by the Division of Purchasing. Each division will be required to obtain approval from their own appropriations for each purchase.

WHEREAS, Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (Am. Sub. H.B. No. 100) was signed into law by Governor Richard F. Celeste on December 4, 1985; and

WHEREAS, effective March 6, 1986, the Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Act provided the opportunity for counties, townships, municipal corporations and school districts to participate in contracts of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for the purchase of supplies, services, equipment, and certain materials; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the City of Columbus to establish an option for the Purchasing Administrator to participate in cooperative purchasing with the State of Ohio by selecting contracts for use by city agencies when it is determined to be the most cost-effective method of obtaining necessary materials, supplies, and equipment; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish this option to participate in cooperative purchasing with the State of Ohio for the immediate preservation of the public health, peace, property, safety and welfare; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBUS:

Section 1. That in making purchases pursuant to Section 329.04, Columbus City Codes, the Purchasing Administrator be and he is hereby authorized and directed to consider and participate in contracts of the State of Ohio, Department of Administrative Services, Office of State Purchasing, for contracts established under Ohio's Cooperative Purchasing Act (Am. Sub. H.B. No. 100).

Section 2. That in recommending purchases pursuant to Section 329.05, Columbus City Codes, to Council, City administrators are encouraged to consider and participate in contracts of the State of Ohio established under the Cooperative Purchasing Act. Council deems it to be in the best interest of the City to waive competitive bidding requirements to permit participation in said contracts, and hereby waives Sections 329.05, 329.06 and 329.14 (a)-(e) inclusive of the Columbus City Codes, 1959, for state contract purchases made pursuant to the Cooperative Purchasing Act.

Section 3. That for the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, or ten (10) days after passage if the Mayor neither approves nor vetoes the same.
