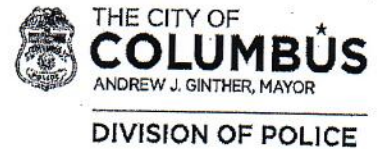

Sir,

The following investigation was conducted concerning the City of Columbus' 2017 annual objection to the renewal of liquor permit **33415690002** issued to **Greathouse Entertainment LLC**, which is doing business as **Turbulence Sports Lounge (O-Lounge)** located at **1536-40 N Cassady Ave. Columbus, Ohio 43219**. The recorded owner of said permit is **Dameon Greathouse and Nancy Greathouse**.

After reviewing the State of Ohio, Franklin County, and City of Columbus records regarding the above liquor permit establishment, the following information has been compiled to support the objection to the renewal of the aforementioned permit issued by the State of Ohio.

The above listed liquor establishment has been issued a **D-2, D2X, D3** and **D-3A** permit by the Division of Liquor. This permit grants the permit holder the privilege to sell alcoholic beverages at the above listed address.

An inquiry of liquor violations revealed that the permit holder has received the following violations between **2016** and **2017**:



SALE AND/OR FURNISHING TO A PERSON UNDER 21

A review of the Columbus Division of Police records revealed the Division of Police have created **(13) thirteen** official police reports concerning incidents at the listed liquor establishment between **January 2016 and November 2017**. These reports referenced thefts, menacing, felonious assaults, simple assaults, liquor law violations, wanted persons, drug offenses, robbery, criminal damaging, and prostitution.

In addition, the Columbus Division of Police have been dispatched to **1536-40 N Cassady Ave.** Columbus, Ohio 43219 on **(46) forty six** calls for service at **O-Lounge**. These calls for service included large fights involving 100 plus patrons, multiple shots fired in parking lot and inside establishment, and shootings at the Waffle House across the street by patrons of O-Lounge following closing time.
