Sharon Young represents the University Community Association (UCA) on the UAC. UCA is the oldest Civic group in the District with it's first minutes dated October of 1961. UCA's boundaries are the same as the UAC with it's membership reaching beyond the District. UCA was instrumental and involved in the writing of the legislation to bring UAC forward to City Council to form the "citizen's arm" to City Council to help with issues that effecting the community.

Sharon has served in this appointed seat on the Commission since 1994 and feels that she has a duty to all of the neighborhoods within the District. She hit the dirt running in 1994 and has held various UAC Executive Board positions, including 1st vice-president and served on UAC subcommittees.

Sharon is a licensed REALTOR and serves the District and downtown neighborhoods. She is extremely involved with the Columbus Board of REALTORS committees, all aspects of affordable housing (including spearheading a home buyer project for CBR which received a National HUD Best Practices Award), has served on Advisory Boards for the Columbus Housing Partnership and the City of Columbus for Home buyer Education and is privileged to serve on an appointed board related to housing for the City of Columbus & Franklin County. In addition, she supports many area organizations that are stackholders in the neighborhoods she works in.
