The Department of Public Service solicited Requests for Proposals for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements – Hilltop Community Mobility Plan Contract. The budget is \$250,000; amount of the contract shall be \$250,000 funded by a 2012 Bonds Funds.

The intent of this project is to provide the City of Columbus, Division of Mobility Options, additional resources for engineering services to preliminary engineer and design recommendations from the Hilltop Community Mobility Plan (HCMP). Work will include detailed design of several features throughout the Greater Hilltop area and will include various engineering design, traffic engineering analysis, education, and surveying tasks.
