This is a contract for the monthly inspection, monitoring and maintenance of the HVAC and Air Purification Equipment currently in use in the Division of Sewerage and Drainage facilities. This contract provides for the necessary preventive and corrective maintenance, repair and all associated reporting related to the performance of this equipment. These facilities consist of the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant (SWWTP), the Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant (JPWWTP) and the Compost Facility.
