Law Enforcement Data Improvement Project – Funding Opportunity

The Ohio Department of Health (ODH) is pleased to announce a one-time funding opportunity, available to law enforcement agencies from a jurisdiction with a population of at least 100,000 Ohio residents as of 2019. Total funding for all jurisdictions will not exceed one hundred and five thousand dollars (\$105,000.00).

These one-time funds shall provide funding to law enforcement agencies to improve the quality, availability, and timeliness of the law enforcement data as it is transmitted to the Ohio Violent Death Reporting System (OH-VDRS). These funds will improve law enforcement data in the following ways: 1. Provide support for additional funding to law enforcement agencies to streamline their electronic reporting. 2. Provide support in maintaining their current electronic reporting systems. 3. Improvement of an electronic system that can help the agencies fulfill requests for reports in a timelier manner. 4. Assisting many state, local, and federal stakeholders with access to accurate and timely data to help direct prevention efforts. The applying agency must be a recognized law enforcement agency in the state of Ohio. The law enforcement agency must oversee a jurisdiction with a population of at least 100,000 Ohio residents as of 2019.

Work completed from November 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022 will be eligible for funds designated to improve law enforcement data. The following deliverables are required to receive the funding:

1. Completed an assessment of improvements needed to provide the following deliverables. (This deliverable has a due date of January 7, 2022, and a one-time payment of \$3,000 will be paid for meeting that deliverable.)
2. Provide comprehensive investigative reports of all violent deaths within six (6) months of opening date of investigation.
3. Provide batch export of reports and investigative notes electronically, upon request (e.g. via ODH's SFTP), or provide other systematic, sustainable mechanism or process for regular provision of this information.
4. Provide access to comprehensive investigative reports, demographic information, scene investigation, incident inventory list, details of weapons involved, officer statements, and details of circumstances surrounding the deaths for the incidents, upon request.

Law enforcement agencies interested in pursuing this funding shall consider the application prerequisites and provide the requested information to apply for these funds.

Application Prerequisites

- a. Applications may be submitted September 20, 2021 through October 4, 2021.
- b. Applications shall serve as funding agreements between ODH and the law enforcement agency.
- c. Funds shall be paid to the Applicants in a one-time payment.
- d. Applications shall be signed and emailed to OHVDRS@odh.ohio.gov.
