



**Build Partnerships and Relationships** - I do community outreach to different social justice networks and organizations as well as build relationships with local and national government officials, schools, churches, and retail locations.

**Committee Coordinator** - Oversees and offer Support to different Committees and their leaders.

**Events and Community Development** - Organized Town Halls, Canvasses, Rallies, Festivals, and Voter Registration Drives all while working closely with a Tabling and Advertising Committee.
