This contract is for HVAC & air purification maintenance services for various Department of Public Utilities (DPU) facilities, including but not limited to the Southerly Wastewater Treatment Plant, Jackson Pike Wastewater Treatment Plant, Compost Facility and Division of Power substations and buildings. Other DPU facilities may be added in the future. The contract work concerns HVAC & air purification units and their associated equipment and systems that require inspection, sampling, testing, troubleshooting, balancing, maintenance, and repair or replacement. This includes maintenance and repair of piping and ductwork. The work may also include updating of software for the various HVAC units or any HVAC associated equipment.

Regular inspection and maintenance of HVAC and air purification equipment helps ensure the equipment operates safely throughout its expected life. This equipment helps ensure required environmental conditions are met in areas housing sensitive electronics crucial to monitoring, operating and controlling many plant processes and equipment. Failure to meet the requirements could cause these components to fail, and removal and replacement would have major budgetary effects. No community outreach or environmental factors are considered for this project.

Unplanned modification. The original contract allows for three (3) extension periods on a year-to-year basis. This unplanned modification is to ensure critical HVAC and air purification maintenance services continue through September 30, 2022, since a temporary delay in advertising bids has prevented the contract process, and thus new bids, from moving forward.

11. An explanation of why the work to be performed as part of the contract modification cannot be bid out. (Indicating the work to be a logical extension of the contract is not sufficient explanation.)

The Department intended to bid the contract out, but the delays mentioned above prevented the process from moving forward. The same exact service is required as originally bid. No lower pricing/more attractive terms and conditions are anticipated at this time.

This contract will be funded incrementally with renewals on approximately an annual basis. Three contract renewals were anticipated and executed (as well as one modification) for various DOSD and DOP Facilities. This requested modification is due to unforeseen bidding issues, as mentioned above. The expected cost for this project is as follows:
