This contract is for the annual inspection and certification (and associated reports discussing the findings), and needed maintenance and repairs or replacement of approximately 200 cranes and hoists and a number of hoisting appurtenances, all in use by the Division of Sewerage and Drainage (DOSD). This specialized work is needed to provide safety-rated operational equipment at our maintenance and process facilities. Additional Department of Public Utilities facilities may be included in the future.

6. **An updated contract timeline to contract completion.**

Year 2 January 21, 2021 to January 20, 2022
Year 3 January 21, 2022 to January 20, 2023
Year 4 January 21, 2023 to January 20, 2024

7. **A narrative discussing the economic impact or economic advantages of the project; community outreach or input in the development of the project; and any environmental factors or advantages of the project.**

The performance of this project's activities to provide crane and hoist inspection, testing, maintenance, repair, reporting and documentation for DPU facility components will help return the affected equipment to service quickly and maintain peak operational efficiency. Utilizing cranes and hoists to assist in maintaining and repairing various process equipment helps prevent small routine repair issues from becoming larger, more expensive work that can have major budgetary effects. No community outreach or environmental factors are considered for this project.

This is the third renewal.

Renewal #1 – \$100,000.00 (PO254378)

Renewal #2 - \$40,000.00 (PO304328)

Renewal #3 - \$60,000.00 (PENDING)

Work under the contract will continue to provide crane & hoist maintenance services for various Division of Sewerage and Drainage facilities.

Anticipated renewal. The original contract allowed for three (3) extension periods on a year-to-year basis. This renewal is to provide the funding necessary for the payment of services provided through January 21, 2024.

The same exact service is required as originally bid. No lower pricing or more attractive terms and conditions are anticipated at this time.

This contract is funded incrementally with renewals/ modifications on approximately an annual basis. Three contract renewals were anticipated, two of which have been executed. If other DPU Facilities are added, or if unforeseen issues or difficulties arise that require additional funding, a modification will be requested. The expected cost for this project is as follows:

Original Contract - \$103,150.00 (PO208922)

Renewal #1 - \$100,000.00 (PO254378)

Renewal #2 - \$40,000.00 (PO304328)

Renewal #3 - \$60,000.00 (PENDING)

Total Estimated Cost - \$303,150.00
