

Site Information

- The 0.4 acre site is an infill annexation.
- The site does not require a boundary conformance.
- The property is owned by Truro Township and involves the transfer of McNaughten Road right of way.
- The property will be used by the Department of Public Service to conform management and maintenance of the right-of-way contiguous to the City of Columbus corporate boundary.

Key Issues

- Annexation is sought to transfer an area of McNaughten Road surrounded on three sides by the City of Columbus, to the City of Columbus.
- Planning staff are processing the annexation application in coordination with Public Service staff. The legislation authorizes the Director of Public Service to file a petition for annexation with the Franklin County Board of Commissioners.

Legislative Information

- This ordinance authorizes the Department of Public Service Director to file a municipal annexation petition on behalf of the City of Columbus with the Franklin County Board of Commissioners.
- After the petition is filed, the commissioners have 30 days to take action.
- This ordinance also provides for the acceptance of the property by the City upon approval by the Franklin County Commissioners.
