Andy's professional experience includes the following:

- In Detroit, Andy worked on a variety of both private and public clients primarily in the manufacturing sector. His last three years in Detroit were spent primarily acting as the lead global audit manager on the Ford Motor Company engagement.
- In early 1999, Andy was transferred to Cologne, Germany to serve as the lead European partner for Ford Motor Company. In this role, Andy coordinates all services to Ford (including Ford of Europe, Jaguar, Volvo Cars and Land Rover) across 22 countries in Europe. He also oversees the US audit reporting for Ford in Europe and the Premier Automotive Group (Land Rover, Jaguar and Volvo Cars).
- Andy currently serves three other public multinationals in Europe: Visteon Corporation, Mazda Motors Corporation and GenCorp. On Visteon, Andy is responsible for coordinating the PricewaterhouseCoopers statutory audit teams in nine countries. On Mazda, Andy is the lead coordinating partner in Europe responsible for overseeing all services to Mazda in twelve countries. He also led the PricewaterhouseCoopers team that assisted Mazda in its successful acquisition of seven companies in Europe.
