CERTIFICATE OF ESTIMATED LIFE AND MAXIMUM MATURITY

The undersigned Auditor of the City of Columbus, Ohio as the fiscal officer of said City, hereby certifies as follows:

1. The estimated life of the improvement described as follows exceeds five years:

Widening, opening, extending, constructing paving, repaving, improving and changing the line of expressways, freeways, roads, highways, bikeways, streets, alleys, bridges, viaducts, bioswales, overpasses, underpasses, grade crossing eliminations, service and access roads, and sidewalks, including development of offstreet parking facilities, the acquisition and installation of parking meters, traffic control systems, equipment and signs, the acquisition of real estate and interests in real estate and related equipment, and landscaping and making site improvements, and refunding bonds previously issued for such purpose

- 2. The amounts proposed to be expended for various classes of improvements, and the maximum maturity of bonds issued for purposes, calculated in accordance with Section 133.20, Ohio Revised Code, are as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto.
- 3. The weighted average of said maturities is 16 years, therefore the maximum maturity of a single issue of bonds to pay the cost of such improvements is 16 years.
