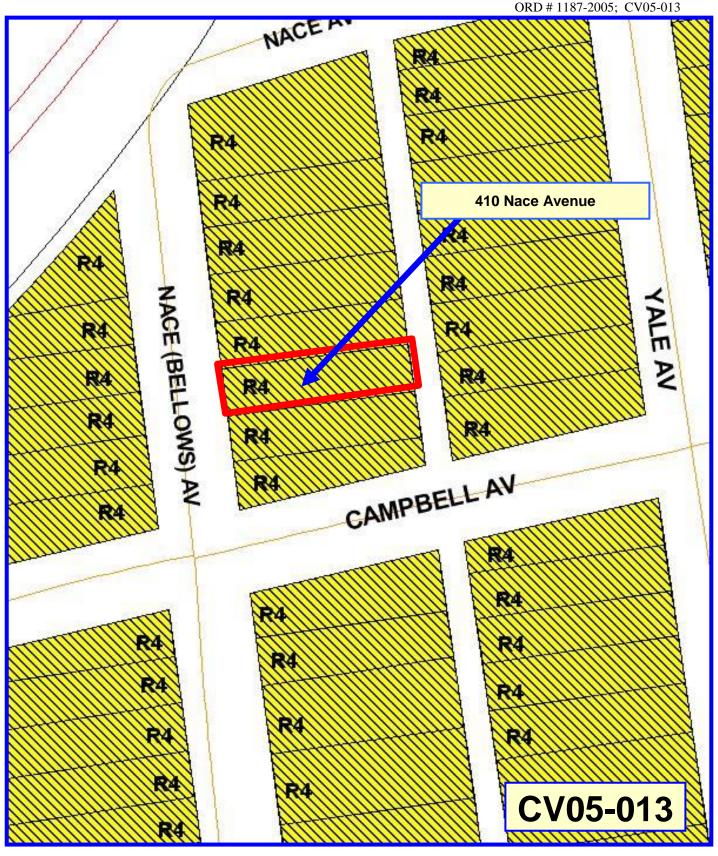
STATEMENT OF HARDSHIP

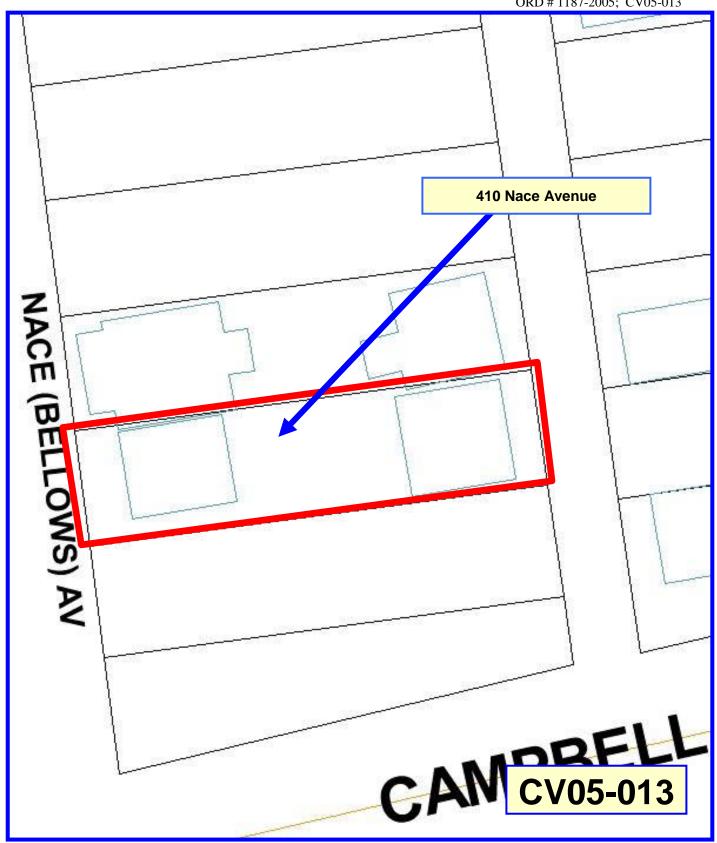
